The Pine Creek Canyon Domestic Water Improvement District (PCCDWID) met in special session. The meeting was telephonically held. The Board may vote to go into Executive Session on any agenda item, pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(3) for legal advice with the District's attorney on matters as set forth in the agenda item.

1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 5:02 PM by Chairman Allan Johnson. Present: Dr. Johnson, Mr. Langley and Mr. Karr, Mr. McClung and Mr. Crews. Also present was Mr. Jones, District Manager and Mr. Ploughe – Hydrogeolist and designer of the deep well in 2009-2010.

- 2. ROLL CALL OF BOARD MEMBERS/DECLARATION OF QUORUM Dr. Johnson, Mr. Langley, Mr. Karr, Mr. McClung and Mr. Crews were all present and a quorum was declared.
- 3. DISCUSS AND TAKE POSSIBLE ACTION RELATED TO issuance of a purchase order for numerous repairs to the District's deep well.

Mr. Jones gave a summary of the current status and steps taken to date to correct the non-working deep well so it can be placed back in service. Mr. Jones reviewed the fact an RFP was provided to eight firms, seven of which quoted. Also, he indicated that he visited the morning this morning with Weber Water Resources to go over details of the project should they be the selected service vendor. Mr. Jones acknowledged he used to be a business partner at Weber Pumping System with Bernie Weber, whose son now runs the business, but he has had no relationship with the Weber family or business since 1984.

After numerous quotations by all Board Members, directed to the District Manager and/or to Mike Ploughe, it was suggested that the question of when to rehabilitate the shallow well should be a topic on the June 16, 2018 board meeting. Also, during the discussion Mr. Crews asked the important question of Mr. Ploughe if there was anything we should do different to the well or its equipment during the rehabilitation process and Mr. Ploughe indicated no change should occur and "if it is not broken, don't try to fix it". His opinion was based on the fact we received 8+ good years of performance of this original pumping system as designed and equipped.

Mr. Jones indicated, if Weber is selected as the pump service provider, they would do the electrical system evaluation on June 8 or June 11, 2018 and they would likely pull all equipment out of the hole on June 12 and 13, 2018 if authorized to proceed. They would then transport the fully assembled pump, motor, and cable to Chandler to their electrical and pump shops for evaluation, inspection, and fitness for continued use. Mr. Jones commented that the transducer and its cable would be sent to In-Situ for testing and evaluation.

Mr. McClung asked why we need to pay sales taxes as a public entity, and he and Mr. Jones agreed to look into the need to do that.

Mr. Langley made a motion to authorize the District Manager to proceed with the proposal from Weber Water Resources. After discussion, that motion was later withdrawn and replaced with a motion by Mr. Crews that would include an overall dollar cap on the project which should not be exceeded without additional approval by the Board. The motion was seconded by Mr. Karr.

The Motion was "to authorize the District Manager to engage Weber Water Resources to proceed under the attached proposal dated May 31, 2018 and to not exceed \$80K in total costs without additional approval by the Board." The motion passed by voice vote. All Board members say Aye. None say Nay.

4. MOTION TO ADJOURN

The meeting was adjourned at 5:35 PM by a voice vote of all.
